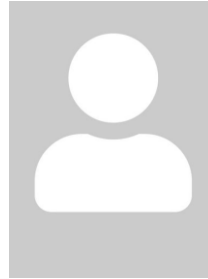

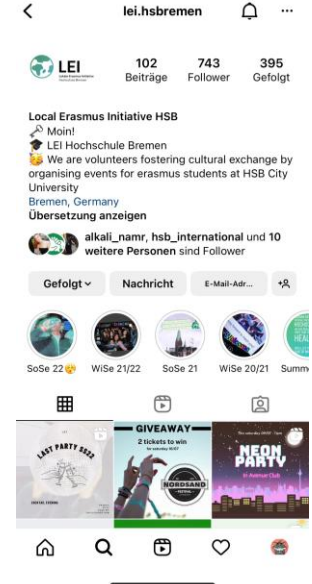

If you need to make a payment in Europe but don't have a European bank account, Wise (www.wise.com) is a simple and low-cost solution

Steps:

1. Sign up for a Wise account at www.wise.com
→ You'll need a valid passport or ID to verify your identity.
2. Open a Multi-Currency Account
→ Select EUR (Euro) as one of your currencies.
→ You will receive your own European IBAN.
3. Add money to your Wise account from your local bank account or credit/debit card.
4. Convert your money into EUR, if needed.
→ Wise uses the real exchange rate with transparent, low fees.
5. Send the payment using your IBAN to the recipient's European bank account.
→ This works for things like course fees, rent, insurance etc.

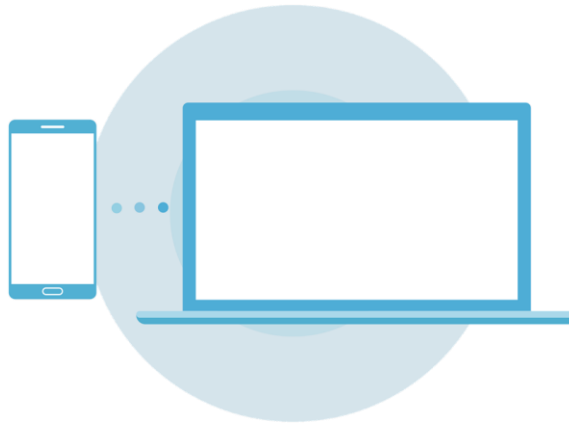
