Course objective	<p>Deepening the skills and competences in caring for an affected adult and/or older patient/person in the context of their own families, family nursing in birth and maternity process, internal medicine, rehabilitation and mental health and substance abuse nursing. All students work as a member of an international and multiprofessional (interprofessional) team during the studies. In addition, during the course students develop nursing professional English speaking and writing communication skills. Learning outcomes: After the course, students are able to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-identify a patient's/client's need for palliative care or convalescent care</li> <li>-implement symptomatic treatment and human palliative care and convalescent care</li> <li>- communicate and interact independently in the native language and at least one foreign language with patients/client from different cultures individually and in a team.</li> <li>- guide and support the patient/client and his / her family (and loved ones) at different health situation</li> <li>- interact professionally and caringly with clients / patients of different ages and life situations and backgrounds (and their loved ones)</li> <li>- make an end-of-life care plan in collaboration with the patient/clients and their relatives, the attending</li> <li>- physician and another multidisciplinary (interprofessional) team</li> <li>- apply Finnish and European nutrition and current care recommendations for different kind of persons/clients and target groups (families) in the prevention and treatment of public diseases and health situations.</li> </ul>
