Hochschule Bremen - Facts & figures


In 1799, it all began with the Bremen Navigation School, forerunner institution of today's Nautical Science and Maritime Transport Department - nowadays the HSB Faculty of Nature and Technology.

Today, HSB is the second largest scientific institution in the Federal state of Bremen.

- 72 degree programs spread across five faculties
- Cooperation with 380 partner universities worldwide
- Appx. 9.000 students:
 - 200 exchange students annually
 - 20% international students on campus








HSB Campuses





- If your visa is **not** valid for your whole stay
- If you are from Australia, Canada, Israel, Japan, New Zealand, Republic of Korea, United Kingdom or USA and entered Germany without a visa
